Feminist Voices for Climate Justice: NE Regional Dialogue 2024

The NE Regional Dialogue highlighted the position, role, and contributions of women from diverse identities in climate justice discussions, often overshadowed by patriarchal perspectives with limited representation of women leaders in key debates and dialogues. Around 117 participants from eight states of North East India gathered to participate in this Regional Dialogue & Exchange - Changing Patterns of Climate Change and Gender Vulnerabilities: Feminist Voices from NE India in September. Women leaders at the dialogue emphasised the need for justice, equality, and the inclusion of grassroots voices in climate action. Read more

NEN Nagaland, in collaboration with G.M. Government High School Chizami, observed World Food Day at Chizami village, Phek district. The campaign initiated conversations on climate change and the food crisis, while creating awareness on indigenous food systems and community knowledge, with interactive sessions, a poster exhibition, and a food recipe competition involving 32 students and 8 teachers.

Engaging in National and International Platforms



NEN is engaged as part of the Civil Society Steering Committee for India to review the progress made in the last three decades on gender equality which was adopted 30 years ago in the 4th World Conference on Women held in Beijing in 1995. Along with Swayam and Point of View, NEN organised an online consultation on gender based violence against women and gender diverse persons to bring together civil society organisations and document their experiences of working on GBV in private, public and digital spaces.



Anurtia P. Hazarika, Executive Director (I/C) of NEN and Vilazonuo, Project Lead, NEN Nagaland, attended the Asia-Pacific Ministerial Conference on the Beijing+30 Review, which was held in November 2024 in Bangkok. The conference was a key milestone in the 30-year regional review of progress in implementing within the Framework for Beijing Platform for Action. Vilazonuo spoke on NEN's work around organising women into collectives for farming and weaving in a side event, "Realising Rights of Women Farmers for a challenges Resilient Future opportunities" organised by MAKAAM, ETC Group, SOPPECOM & UN Women.



Anurita, Iaimanda A. Ryngksai, State Coordinator, NEN Meghalaya, and Rashmi Rekha Borah, Project Lead, NEN Assam, attended the Aman National meeting held at Patna, sharing the space with 60 representatives from 28 organisations. Established in 2006, the primary objective of the network is to support survivors of domestic violence by providing case referral services and capacity building across the country.
